Instructions

- 1. Choose your store! Find a photo of it online or sketch an image on paper from memory.
- 2. Paste on the door, windows, awning, and any decorations to the bottom of your box. This will be the front of your store.
- 3. Turn the box over to work on the inside of the store model.
- **Experiment with different materials** 4. and textures to bring alive your interior-design skills!
- 5. Use collage to decorate the walls of your store.
- Try folding paper to make aisles or 6. shelves.
- 7. Tape and glue objects and images to the store's floor, walls, and ceiling.
- 8. Open your store for business!
