POSITION DESCRIPTION

Brooklyn Children's Museum seeks a Manager of STEM Learning to oversee science content for education programs throughout the Museum. The Manager will create and facilitate school program and public program offerings in the Museum's maker space, develop program schedules, set standards for program delivery, and train and manage Museum Educators delivering science programs.

This is a highly collaborative position that requires effective leadership and participation on cross-functional teams, as well as frequent inter-departmental communication and cooperation. Successful candidates will be organized project managers; creative thinkers and problem solvers; strong verbal and written communicators; and dynamic team leaders. Ability to work with diverse audiences and willingness to interact with the public are essential. BCM seeks candidates who share our commitment to creating a respectful, collaborative, purpose-driven and joyful work culture.

The position supervises 2-4 part-time direct reports.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee the development, implementation, and evaluation of innovative natural science and STEM programs utilizing assets from the Museum's collection of cultural objects and natural science specimens and live animals. These include rotating public programs in BCM's *Nature's Engineer's* maker space, school programs, and offsite programs.
- Provide direct management of all Educators supporting and facilitating programs in *Nature's Engineer's*, BCM's maker space.
- Contribute to the development of aquaria and animal programs, seeking opportunities to integrate relevant cultural elements and collections into these programs.
- Steward and provide support for the Museum's STEM Educator Advisory Council and plan meetings, content review, and prototyping.
- Collaborate with Evaluation consultant on the collection of surveys and qualitative and quantitative feedback.

- Teach and facilitate school programs and public programs as needed.
- Represent the Museum at conferences and other professional networking opportunities and events.
- Other Education department and Museum-wide responsibilities as needed.

PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree in Natural Sciences or Environmental Sciences, Animal Husbandry, Museum Education or related field, with a focus on science programming
- 3-5 years working in a museum or other informal education setting
- Demonstrated management experience
- Experience writing lesson plans, developing and delivering programs based on interdisciplinary and science themes for early childhood-age audiences
- Exemplary verbal and written communication
- Ability and desire to work collaboratively as part of an interdisciplinary team and be open to constructive feedback and exchange
- Warmth, positive energy, and a sincere love of working with children and families
- Familiarity with Brooklyn and its diverse communities preferred
- Active interest and commitment to social justice initiatives, racial equity and inclusion
- Proficient with Macs, PCs, Microsoft Office, Google Apps, and Dropbox
